

**THE COUNTRY DAY SCHOOL
TUITION PROTECTION PLAN**

Participation in The Country Day School's Tuition Protection Plan is required for all enrollees at The Country Day School not paying full tuition by July 1, 2009. The charge for the Tuition Protection Plan is five percent (5%) of the total tuition. By signing the Enrollment Contract and paying the tuition protection fee, the parents or guardians of the enrolled student authorize The Country Day School to process any claim for payment of tuition to which the said parents or guardians are entitled under this tuition protection plan; said payment to be credited to the enrolled student's tuition account, paying any excess to the parents or guardians. **However, if there is a balance due The Country Day School after processing a claim under the Tuition Protection Plan, the parents or guardians are legally liable to pay such balance to The Country Day School.**

FOR THOSE PARENTS OR GUARDIANS WHO PAY TUITION IN FULL BY JULY 1, 2009 PARTICIPATION IN THE TUITION PROTECTION PLAN IS NOT REQUIRED, BUT IT IS STRONGLY RECOMMENDED. THERE WILL BE NO REFUND OF TUITION, UNDER ANY CIRCUMSTANCES, UNLESS PARTICIPATION IN THE TUITION PROTECTION PLAN IS AFFIRMED BY PAYMENT OF A TUITION PROTECTION FEE AT THE RATE OF FIVE PERCENT (5%) OF THE TOTAL TUITION.

The following benefit schedule is in force and effect for the academic year 2009-2010:

1. In the event any student enrolled in the Tuition Protection Plan has attended The Country Day School for more than fifteen (15) consecutive days from the first "class day" of attendance, and the student is disabled by reason of injury or sickness, and is thereby continuously prevented from attending all scheduled classes for the remainder of the current academic school year, one hundred percent (100%) of any "unearned" tuition due to or from the student will be credited to the student's tuition account, with any excess being paid to the student's parents or legal guardians. During his/her period of incapacity, the student must be regularly treated by a doctor. ("Doctor" means any medical doctor (MD) or, where required by law, any other medical practitioner in respect to services performed within the scope of the doctor's license. The doctor must be other than a member of the student's family.) Notice to The Country Day School must include a doctor's written statement which medically certifies that the sickness or injury prevents the student from attending all scheduled classes for the remainder of the current academic school year.
2. In the event any student has attended The Country Day School for more than fifteen (15) consecutive days from the first "class day" of attendance and is dismissed by The Country Day School for scholastic or disciplinary reasons, or withdraws or is withdrawn for any reason other than specified in paragraph 1 above, sixty percent (60%) of any "unearned" tuition due to or from the student will be credited to the student's tuition account, with any excess being paid to the student's parents or legal guardians.

SCHOOL TERM: From September 1, 2009, to June 15, 2010

Policy Term Rate: 5%

Rate x total tuition = contract term fee (Early Bird Rate)

Smart Start through Eighth (5% x \$6,795) = \$339.75

Smart Start through Eighth (5% x \$7,175) = \$358.75
